Notes:

FST 110 and FST 111 are taught in back-to-back eight-week sessions each fall and spring semester.

Either EMT 174 or FST 110/111 can be taken first. Neither is a prerequisite to the other.

Students must complete EMT 174 with a grade of B or better. To prepare for state or national certification, students must 1) complete EMT 174 with a grade of B or better, 2) pass final exams with a grade of B or better, 3) document ten (10) patient contacts in the field, and 4) be 18 when the EMT 174 course begins.
