# California General Education Transfer Curriculum 2025-2026

The California General Education Transfer Curriculum (**CalGETC**) is a general education pattern that allows California community college students to fulfill lower-division general education requirements for transfer to both California State University (CSU) and University of California (UC) campuses. CalGETC provides a well-rounded academic foundation by including coursework in: English Communication, Quantitative & Scientific Reasoning, Arts & Humanities, Social & Behavioral Sciences, and Ethnic studies.

<p><b>Hartnell College CalGETC has a total of 34 units and includes the following areas:</b></p> <p><b>Area 1:</b> English Communication</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1A: English Composition</li> <li>1B: Critical Thinking &amp; Composition</li> <li>1C: Oral Communication</li> </ul> <p><b>Area 2:</b> Mathematical Concepts &amp; Quantitative Reasoning</p> <p><b>Area 3:</b> Arts &amp; Humanities</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3A: Arts</li> <li>3B: Humanities</li> </ul> <p><b>Area 4:</b> Social &amp; Behavioral Sciences</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>2 courses from 2 different disciplines</li> </ul> <p><b>Area 5:</b> Physical &amp; Biological Sciences</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>5A: Physical Science</li> <li>5B: Biological Science</li> <li>5C: Science Laboratory</li> </ul> <p><b>Area 6:</b> Ethnic Studies</p>	<p><b>CalGETC Certification:</b> Certification means that Hartnell College has officially verified that a student has completed the lower-division general education requirements for transfer to a University of California (UC) or California State University (CSU) campus under the CalGETC pattern.</p> <p><b>Why Certification Matters:</b> Certification is essential because, without it, students may be required to complete additional lower-division general education courses after transferring. A certified CalGETC pattern confirms that general education requirements have been fulfilled at the community college level.</p> <p><b>Pass-Along Certification:</b> Including Coursework from Other Colleges Courses taken at other colleges or universities may be considered for CalGETC certification through a process known as pass-along certification:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Courses from other California Community Colleges will be certified in the same CalGETC areas (Areas 1-6) that were approved by the original institution.</li> <li>Courses from other regionally accredited colleges or universities may be certified only if they are determined to be equivalent to courses on Hartnell College's CalGETC approved list.</li> </ol>

<p><b>CalGETC Guidelines</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Complete one course in each required CalGETC area.</li> <li>Courses must be on the approved CalGETC list for the term in which they were taken.</li> <li>A grade of "C" or better is required in all CalGETC courses.</li> <li>Double-counting of courses is permitted between CalGETC and major preparation, but not within multiple GE areas, even if a course is listed in more than one area; it can only be used to satisfy one GE area.</li> <li>Certification of CalGETC completion will be awarded by Admissions and Records if all requirements have been met.</li> </ul> <p><b>Please Note:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Courses marked with an asterisk (**) indicate transfer unit limitations by the CSU, UC, or both.
